Performance Notes

This song was written specifically for communion on Sunday 3 B of Lent, which features the dramatic temple scene in which Jesus, the new temple of God, says, “Destroy this temple and in three days I shall raise it up.” Paul reflects on the crucified Christ as the wisdom of God in the second reading, and in the first, Moses urges the people to “keep holy the sabbath day,” anticipating Jesus’ criticism of the moneychangers in the gospel. By echoing these themes during communion, the song’s aim is to extend and deepen the assembly’s communal “lectio divina” or prayerful hearing of the word on this day.
