Valleys of Green

Many people love Psalm 23 and its central, reassuring image of God as being the one who shepherds and guides our lives. Some will recognize this piece as a re-incarnation of a previously published song. The text has been updated and a new keyboard accompaniment has been written, while the original character and theme remain. The prayer in this setting directly addresses God, seeking the Lord's protection and guidance. The mood is one of quiet, gentle reassurance.

Originally, the piece was scored for guitar accompaniment, but a keyboard part has been included in print for the first time, for those who might not have a guitarist available. If a guitar is used, the gentle character of the piece suggests using a fingerpicking pattern rather than a strumming rhythm. Guitar and piano can work well together if one takes the lead and the other simply provides color and ornamentation.

This new arrangement includes SAB parts, so it can be a choral piece, if desired. The verses can be sung by a soloist or by choir with the assembly joining on the refrain. Because of its length, this is an ideal Communion hymn for funeral liturgies and is also very appropriate for wake services and memorials. With the extended refrain, it would not be a good responsorial psalm.


