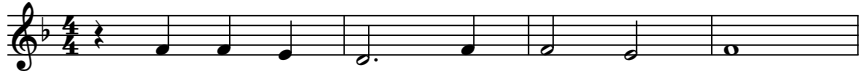
As always, begin the song in unison and add the choral parts as the song progresses. I like to have my choirs sing the final verse *a cappella*. The accompaniment should be simple throughout.
