Composer Notes

This text has a strong paschal emphasis—how the Church, born from Christ's compassion and self-sacrifice, is called to imitate him. It is equally appropriate for the sprinkling or communion rite, and so has a companion Lamb of God setting.

Specific uses throughout the year include:

- Lent 3A (Living Water: Vss 2–4, Preparation or Communion)
- Easter Vigil
- Easter 5A (2nd Reading: The Lord, a living stone)
- Dedication or Anniversary of a Church

- Sprinkling: especially in Easter Season
- Preparation or Communion: Easter Season
- Funeral: Sprinkling with Holy Water
