Performance Notes

“Great Is the Power We Proclaim” was written for the Silver Jubilee of Clifton Cathedral, England. It may be sung as a gathering song during the Rites of Initiation (Acceptance, Election, Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist), and as a song for mission or discipleship.

If you are able to use a piano and an organ for the accompaniment, the song will have extra power and rhythmic drive. For festive occasions, brass parts may be used (2 trumpets and 2 trombones, edition 70257). Trumpets may be used alone if trombones are not available. “Great Is the Power We Proclaim” is recorded on the RCIA resource collection: *Christ We Proclaim*.
