



## Performance Notes

Sing “Mary, Ponder In Your Heart” on feasts of our Lady, especially the Annunciation (March 25) and Mary, Mother of God (January 1). The text is also especially appropriate for the Fourth Sunday of Advent, when the gospel of the annunciation is read.

For variety, the keyboard part may be played an octave higher in Verse 2. For the choral parts, try Verse 1: women, Verse 2: men (singing the melody); Verse 3: women on the melody, men on the harmony.
