## Composer's Notes

This song of remembrance was written in memory of Ione M. Kinghorn, Carol Jean's mother and my mother-in-law. She was the wife of Fred Kinghorn, mother of ten children, a grandmother, and great-grandmother. She was a woman of deep faith and integrity, "a blessed gift to her family and a love song of God to us all." I have used this song most effectively at memorial services. It is most appropriate just before or after reading the names of those we are remembering. I have also used this song at a funeral liturgy, as a communion meditation. It is also very effective during a wake service. Sing it prayerfully and tenderly. It is best interpreted by a cantor with a small group of singers or a choir.
