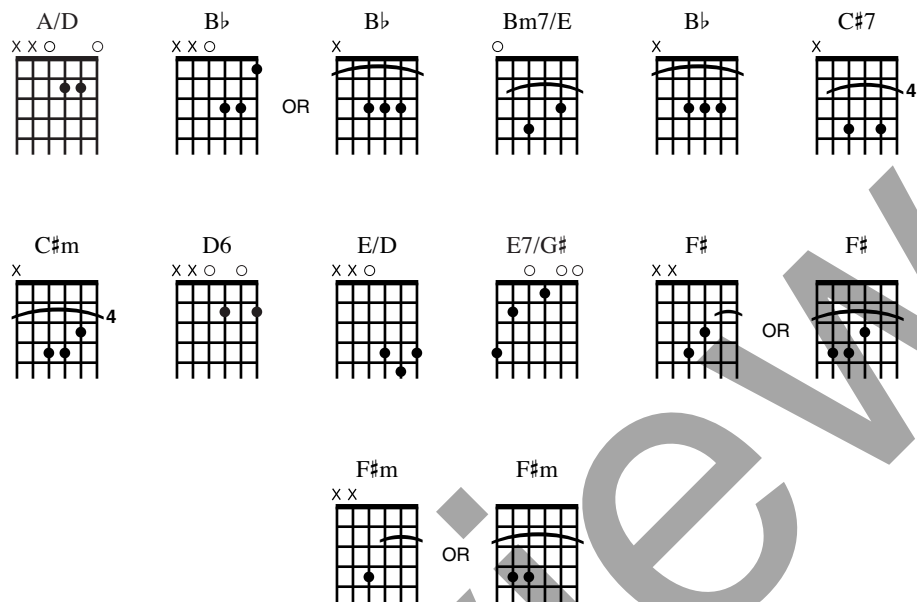
Performance Notes
