## Composer Notes

Reunirse al principio de la Misa no es una meta en sí. Esta acción sirve para prepararnos a escuchar la Palabra de Dios, la cual es “una lámpara para nuestros pies y una luz para nuestro camino” (Salmo 118). Este canto, en estilo de cumbia, se basa en los textos de varios salmos para resaltar el propósito del rito de entrada. Sólo unidos como asamblea en Cristo, Palabra encarnada, nos reunimos ante la mesa de la Plegaria eucarística y la Comunión para, luego, ir al mundo a servir.
