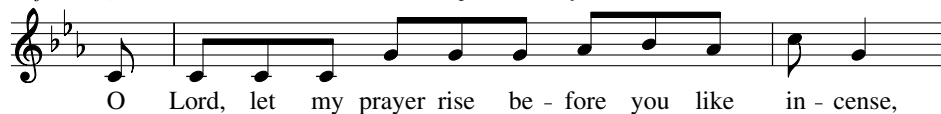


PSALM 141: O LORD, LET MY PRAYER RISE

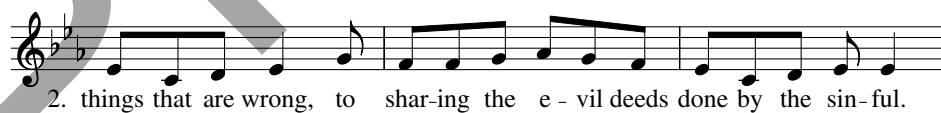
Refrain: (♩ = 42 - 46) 1st time: Cantor, All repeat; thereafter: All
