Composer Notes

This poignant reflection of Christ's sacrifice is appropriate for the season of Lent and Holy Week. It is a powerful reflection following the reading of the Passion on Palm Sunday and Good Friday.

It is important not to rush this hymn, so that the words may sink in. If used as a congregational hymn, verses 3 and 4 might be sung by the choir alone, with the assembly returning on verse 5. If used as a choir anthem, verse 1 might be sung by a soloist and verse 2 sung as a duet.
