Composer Notes

This song for use at the end of Mass or other liturgical celebrations is ideal when the focus is mission, stewardship, service, using gifts, justice and peace, as well as other occasions. Its first line echoes a favorite dismissal text of deacons in the 1973 Sacramentary, still in use at the time it was written. The composer delights in giving new life to this beloved text which is sadly no longer included as an option in the revised *Roman Missal*.


Originally written as a recessional song for Mass at the end of a meeting of the Portsmouth Diocesan Pastoral Council, this piece is dedicated in homage to the late Sydney Carter (1915–2004, author/arranger of “Lord of the Dance”) since it imitates some aspects of his characteristic English folksong style.
