## Notes

“Lord, Make Us Turn To You,” the responsorial psalm from the Advent Mass *The Coming*, is the appointed Psalm for the first Sunday of Advent cycle B, and fourth Sunday of Advent cycle C.

A unique feature of this psalm setting occurs in the closing measures, which contain a brief choral counterpoint in repetition on the phrase “we shall be saved.”
