Composer Notes

It is interesting to note that the official Entrance Antiphon for Holy Thursday is not a eucharistic text, as might be expected for the celebration of the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. Rather, the text is taken from Galatians 6:14 —Saint Paul's reflection on the triumph of the Cross. This is fitting since Holy Thursday is not an isolated liturgy, but the beginning of the sacred Paschal Triduum, when Christians commemorate the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ with a continuous three-day celebration.

We utilize the complete official text of the antiphon for our refrain. Nothing in this text is altered or repeated. The gospel-style setting is easily learned by the assembly. We recommend introducing this song on the Fourth or Fifth Sunday of Lent as a Prelude or Communion song to help your assembly learn the melody in preparation for Holy Thursday.

There are two sets of verses. The first set is a paraphrase of Psalm 67 (66), as recommended by the *Roman Graduale* for the verses of the Holy Thursday Entrance Antiphon. The second set of verses are original text that make the song useable throughout the Easter season.

This setting is also recommended for September 14, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, on which this very same Galatians text is utilized as the Entrance Antiphon.
