## Composer Notes

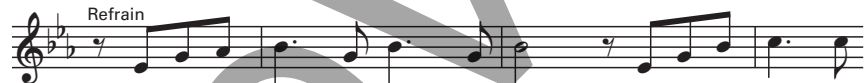
