Composer Notes

“O Sacrum Convivium” is a communion song based on the antiphon to the Magnificat of Evening Prayer II for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi:

O sacred banquet,
 in which Christ is received,
 the memory of his Passion is renewed,
 the mind is filled with grace,
 and a pledge of future glory is given to us.
 Alleluia.

The text is attributed to St. Thomas Aquinas. In my refrain I added St. Paul (1 Cor. 6:15; 1 Cor. 10:17) and St. Augustine’s assertion (Sermon 227) that in the Eucharist we become what we receive. Threaded throughout the verses are the seven corporal works of mercy. Jerry Chiusano arranged this for keyboard, oboe, two trumpets, horn, trombone, and timpani.


